### **Include the following in your covering letter:**

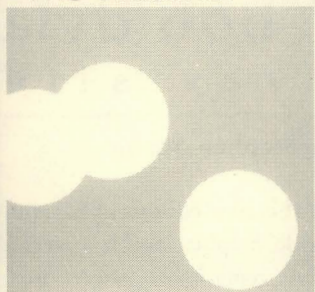

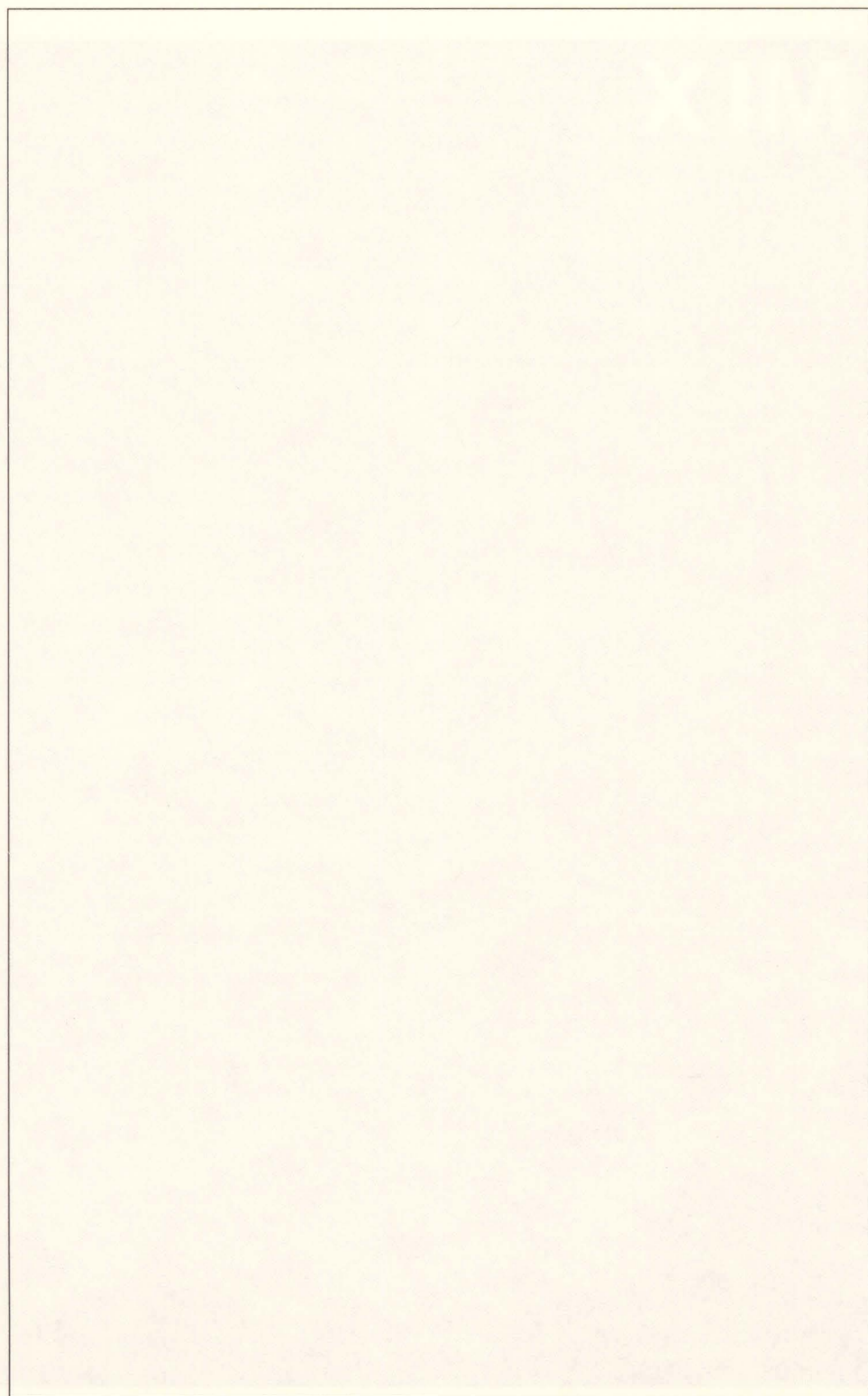
