## Gathie Falk / BOOT CASE DRAWINGS

Although for many years Gathie has loved to draw on the surface of ceramic or wooden sculpture, and to draw in preparation for photosilkscreen prints, only recently has she attempted a major drawing exhibition. The series illustrated here (exhibited at the Bau-Xi Gallery, February 23 - March 8, 1976) employs the drawn "boot case" to contain images of her daily life — cups and saucers, house plants, candlesticks — coupled with those of her art and fantasy life — Dürer rabbits, moths born in cups, birds in light-bulb Annunciation. Some of these drawings will travel in company with twenty-four hand-drawn, wooden horses of Herd No. 1 in the National Gallery Ottawa's National Programme exhibits during 1976-1977.
