## GUIDELINES FOR CONTRIBUTORS

<u>Technostyle</u> publishes articles, notes and commentaries for instructors and practitioners in the fields of technical communication and business communication. Articles present research findings and in-depth analyses, while notes are narrower in scope and focus on a specific teaching or writing technique. All submissions to <u>Technostyle</u> should be original and accurate. Papers may be submitted in English or French, accompanied by a fifty-word abstract in the second language (even a rough translation will help the editors). All submissions will be evaluated by the Editor and anonymous readers.

Submit all papers in triplicate, typed double-spaced on one side only of  $8 \ 1/2-x-11$ -inch paper. Articles should not exceed 4000 words. Include all references on separate pages at the end of the article, following one of these standard formats: Chicago; MLA; APA. Graphics should be in camera-ready form. Include a brief biographical sketch on a separate page with your submission.

Please include a self-addressed stamped envelope with your submission, and proofread submissions carefully.
