Evaluation: Text, Teaching, Training

Like our 1992 meeting, our 1993 meeting will provide for two types of sessions:

- (a) sessions of formal, research-based papers. Presenters of these papers may be eligible for SSHRC assistance with *travel* costs, if their own institutions cannot provide such assistance. Presenters who require travel funding should so indicate when they submit their proposals. All those who propose formal papers should take special care that their submissions demonstrate the research orientation of their proposals.
- (b) "poster" sessions. Less formal than research sessions, these will offer 10-minute presentations which focus on classroom issues and strategies. Presenters of poster sessions are not eligible for SSHRC travel funding.
