JANET GILTROW, past president of CATTW (1993–1995), has been awarded one of 10 prestigious fellowships by 3M Canada Inc. and the Society for Teaching and Learning in Higher Education. The award recognizes teaching excellence as well as educational leadership.

Giltrow's citation credits her "impressive leadership" in the teaching of writing. She was instrumental in the development of the Simon Fraser University English department's writing centre, and a driving force behind research and enhancements to the department's writing program.

Janet Giltrow has played a strong role in the recent growth and development of CATTW. She is author of the books, *Academic Writing: Writing and Reading Across the Disciplines*, and *Academic Reading: Reading and Writing Across the Disciplines*.
