

TABLE S1: BIRD SPECIES RECORDED IN THE RIO TIGRE BASIN

This appendix contains the complete list of bird species registered in the río Tigre basin by authors Juan Díaz-Alván, Jacob Socolar, and José Álvarez during fieldwork from 1991–2014. In addition to scientific and English names for each species, the list contains the following annotations and abbreviations:

ABUNDANCE

All species are assigned an abundance based on observation frequency:

C	Common; > 9 individuals observed on most days in appropriate habitat.
F	Fairly common; observed most days in appropriate habitat (< 9 individuals).
U	Uncommon to rare; encountered at least three times, but not on most days.
R	Very rare; encountered 1–3 times.
X	Accidental; biogeographic evidence suggests occurrence is abnormal.
C*; F*; U*	Locally [common; fairly common; uncommon]. Attains given abundance in geographically restricted parts of the basin.

HABITAT

All species are categorized by the habitat(s) in which they were found:

Fl	Floodplain forest, excluding swamps dominated by the palm <i>Mauritia flexuosa</i> .
