

The Society was organized in the fall of 1989. As a result of our efforts over the past year, over 1,800 individuals have elected to join ISSSEEM. Of that number, 17% are physicians, 28% have completed their doctoral work, 20% have completed a masters, 17% a bachelors. We feel that psychology, psychophysiology, psychophysics, and medicine are rapidly coming together in a synthesis that will keynote an innovative science of the 21st century. It is the hope of the leadership of the society that through carefully prepared and edited publications the Society will stimulate ISSSEEM interest in the greater scientific community.

Subtle Energies & Energy Medicine is a premier peer-reviewed, scientific journal designed to meet the needs of experimental scientists, other empirical researchers, clinicians, and theoreticians with interests in consciousness, healing, and the dynamics and limits of human potential. Published papers address the study of subtle energies and informational systems that interact with the human psyche and physiology, either enhancing or perturbing healthy homeostasis.

Membership dues sustain the Central Office and provide members with a quarterly magazine, *Bridges.* The Society encourages the exchange of information through conferences, seminars, and workshops. An annual conference is planned in June of every year.
