The International Society for the Study of Subtle Energies and Energy Medicine (ISSSEEM), is an interdisciplinary organization for the study of energetic and informational interactions. The Society is concerned with the study of informational systems and energies that interact with the human psyche and physiology, either enhancing or perturbing healthy homeostasis.

The Society was organized in the fall of 1989. As a result of our efforts over the past four years, approximately 2,000 individuals have elected to support ISSSEEM activities. Of that number, from those who have provided educational background information, the following breakdown was developed: 16% are physicians, 29% have completed their doctoral work, 18% have completed a masters, 15% a bachelors. We feel that psychology, psychophysiology, psychophysics, and medicine are rapidly coming together in a synthesis that will keynote an innovative science of the 21st century. It is the hope of the leadership of the Society that through carefully prepared and edited publications the Society will stimulate ISSSEEM interest in the greater scientific community.

Membership dues sustain the Central office and provide members with quarterly newsletters and general mailings. The Society encourages the exchange of information through conferences, seminars, and workshops. The third annual conference will be held in Monterey, California June 25-29, 1993.
