Being the editor responsible for the contents of the OSTIV Section, Alex Stirnemann declared himself willing to undertake the responsibility for having the manuscripts printed, for making the reprints on behalf of the OSTIV Publications and for the administration of the payments to the Swiss Aero Club for OSTIV's "Aero Revue" subscriptions for the benefit of its individual members.


This task was extended in 1963, when the OSTIV Board decided in its meeting at Calcinate del Pesce on September 12, to appoint a "Press and Public Relations Officer", and Alex Stirnemann was willing to undertake this duty also.

Although it is not so easy to create general and permanent interest for the activities of an organization of the particular character of OSTIV, Stirnemann's "Press Bulletins", forwarded to the international aviation press, made OSTIV better known, so that a better understanding of its purpose as well as its activities was achieved in several countries.

Alex Stirnemann had an important share in the completion of eight OSTIV books, namely in Publications IV to IX inclusive as well as in The World's Sailplanes I and II.

With great devotion to his duties for OSTIV—which he voluntarily took upon himself—Stirnemann has rendered exceptional service to our organization. It is for this reason that the General Conference of Active Members of OSTIV in Leszno on June 22 1968 unanimously decided to award the special Diploma for Exceptional Service to OSTIV, for the first time after its creation, to Alex Stirnemann.

The rare combination of punctuality and artistry as well as reliability together with readiness to fight for his beliefs, straight, never behind one's back, has made always a deep

impression on me. A strong and outstanding personality ever ready to support new ideas and progressive actions. It is therefore understandable that I accepted with great pleasure the invitations of the President of the Swiss Aero Club, Mr. F. Rickenbacher, to deliver the OSTIV Diploma personally to Alex Stirnemann during the Conference of Delegates of this Aero Club in Thun on Saturday, November 16, 1968.
