Papers should be typed double-spaced on standard size pages. Papers of great length may have to be divided and published serially. Each paper should be accompanied by a 100-200 word abstract which summarizes in a single paragraph the subjects treated in the paper and the principal observations or conclusions of the investigation. The equations and symbols may be handwritten or typed. In all cases, they should be clear and unambiguous. References should be grouped at the end of the manuscript. Line drawings must be clearly done using black ink on white paper. Plan the figures so that wherever possible they can be reduced to a single column width without loss of legibility. Photographs should be glossy prints, not matte. Each figure and table must have a caption.
